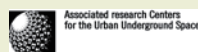

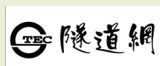

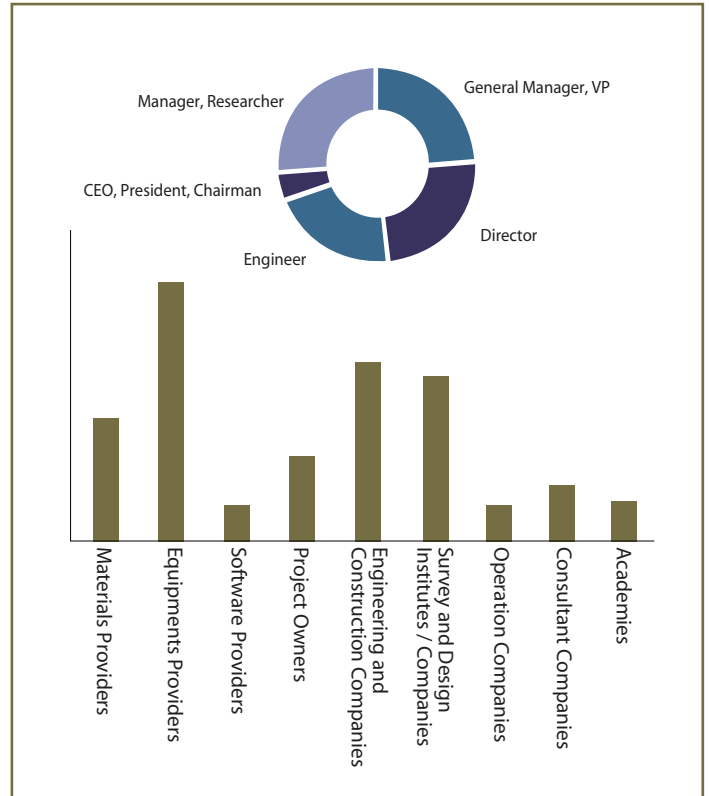


INTRODUCTION
